ADDITIVE WORK BIDDING

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) has a planned amount of funds for this project. If awarded, the Secretary will award a single contract for the Base bid and any Additive bids accepted.

I. DEFINITIONS:

Base bid: The minimum amount of work that may be awarded.

Additive bid: Work that may be awarded in addition to the work included in the Base bid.

II. BIDDING PROCEDURES:

a. The contract is divided into the following prioritized segments for bidding purposes:

PRIORITY	BID	SECTION
1	Base bid	1 thru 8
2	Additive bid No. 1	9
3	Additive bid No. 2	10
4	Additive bid No. 3	11

b. Contractors are required to include prices for the Base bid and all Additive bids. Any proposal submitted without the Base bid and all Additive bids will be considered non-responsive and will be rejected under **subsection 102.17** "REJECTION OF PROPOSALS; NON-RESPONSIVENESS."

III. CONTRACT TIME:

a. Contract time is determined by adding the time for the Base bid and all Additive bids that are awarded as shown in the following table. The time will be assigned to the contract as set forth in the table following execution of the contract. Cleanup time will be determined as per **subsection 108.4** "CONTRACT TIME-GENERAL" after the contract time is calculated.

Base bid	30 Working days
Additive bid No. 1	5 Additional Working Days
Additive bid No. 2	10 Additional Working Days
Additive bid No. 3	15 Additional Working Days

IV. DBE GOAL:

The DBE goal shown on the latest revision of the "Required Contract Provision (07-19-80)" is based on the items of work in the Base bid. The Contractor awarded the project shall meet the goal or show good faith efforts to meet the DBE goal using the items of work contained in the Base bid.

V. CONTRACT AWARD DETERMINATION:

- a. The Additive bids are prioritized in the order they are listed. After the letting, the low bidder will be determined by considering the Base bid plus the total of any Additive bid accepted in the order of priority listed.
- b. The Secretary may accept or reject any or all Additive bids except as limited by the order of priority.
- c. The Secretary may award the contract in excess of the planned amount, if it would not change the low bidder using the planned amount.
- d. The bidder waives the right to claim the bidder misunderstood the terms, conditions, and provisions of this Additive Bidding specification. This specification modifies **subsection 103.1** "AWARD OF CONTRACT" for purposes of calculating the lowest cost.

5. Contractors shall use the AASHTO's EXPEDITE software in combination with the electronic bidding system file created for the Project with EXPEDITE software [EBS file] to generate an electronic internet proposal. The EXPEDITE software and Project EBS file are available on Bid Express' website at <http://www.bidx.com>.

6. Contractors shall only use the EXPEDITE software to create a proposal and submit an electronic internet proposal to KDOT using the Bid Express website at <http://www.bidx.com>.

7. The KDOT Bureau of Construction and Materials will only accept electronic internet proposals on-line using Bid Express until 1:00 P.M. Local Time on the Letting Date. KDOT will open and read these proposals at the Eisenhower State Office Building, 700 SW Harrison, Topeka, Kansas 66603 at 1:30 P.M. Local Time on the Letting Date. 8. The Contractor shall execute a contract for the proposed work within ten (10) business days after notice of the award of the contract.

9. The Contractor shall complete the work within 60 working days and number of cleanup days allowed by the Standard Specifications subsection 108.4 or within the time specified in Project Special Provision "Work Schedule", if applicable.

10. The Contractor shall complete the Project according to the plans, Standard Specifications, provisions identified in the Special Provision List and all other Contract Documents identified in Standard Specifications subsection 101.3.
